REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION TO UPPER DIVISION (300/400-LEVEL COURSES)

To enroll in DBE 300/400-level courses, students must be admitted to the Department of Business and Economics. To be admitted to DBE, students must first:

1. **Earn an overall grade point average of 2.3 or higher.** This requirement applies to all students, **including transfer students.** Coursework at previously attended colleges or universities will be included in GPA computations.
2. Complete the following courses with a **GPA of at least 2.0 and no grade lower than C -**: CIS 108; ACCT 200, 201; BUS 270; ECON 250, and 251.
3. Complete the following: MATH 151 (MATH 240 may substitute for MATH 151); ENGL 101, 102; COMM 110; and all but 12 credits of the remaining University General Education requirements. **Students with majors offered by the Department of Business and Economics may not enroll in any of the courses listed above on a Pass/Fail basis.** The General Education Mathematics requirement is satisfied by MATH 151 or MATH 240.

All of the requirements stated above also apply to transfer students.
