

## **Fred N. Johnston Educational Administration Graduate Scholarship**

The Educational Administration Department offers two Scholarships annually to students enrolled in the Educational Administration program. These scholarships were established with a generous Fred Johnston and Robert D. Krey Endowment gifts to the Educational Administration Department at the University of Wisconsin Superior. The Fred N. Johnston scholarship is primarily based on academic achievement, demonstrated commitment to education, and the likelihood of becoming a rural school administrator.

Nomination and selection for these scholarships is made by the faculty following the listed criteria.

### Eligibility Requirements

The scholarship is available to an applicant who meets the following criteria:

1. must be admitted into the Educational Administration Program and is a commencing student.
2. must be pursuing a Master of Science in Education or Specialist Degree in Education. Students enrolled as “Certification Only” are not eligible.
3. must have earned cumulative 3.65 GPA for educational administration graduate coursework.

### Evaluation Criteria

The judging will be based on the following criteria:

1. Faculty Member’s Recommendation Form
2. Application Narrative

### Application Format

Submissions must consist of three parts as follows:

1. An application narrative (not exceed five pages, doubled spaced) Including, in any order, the following key points:
  - A description of the Applicant’s activities demonstrating educational leadership and community involvement, elaborating on the role that they have played in their educational community;
  - A list of scholastic or professional recognition received; and
  - A narrative of applicant’s understanding of what rural K-12 education is all about and what they hope to bring to education through their future goals and professional aspirations.
2. A faculty reference form completed by an Educational Administration faculty member.
3. An application form.
