

## PRAXIS II Content Testing Requirement for Wisconsin Teaching Licensure

All graduates of UW-Superior undergraduate TED programs (elementary, secondary and K-12) must pass the content test(s) selected by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI). The “Subject Assessment” tests of the **Praxis II** series of the Educational Testing Service (ETS) are serving as the licensure testing.

**Before** a student will be considered for student teaching placement., the appropriate WI content test(s) must be taken by the student and passing score(s) received by the TED Office of Field Experience by February 15 for the following Fall placements and by September 15<sup>th</sup> for the following Spring placements. The passing scores were set by DPI effective July 1, 2004 and are listed below. The TED department reserves the right to require a score exceeding that established by DPI. Remember that each state sets its own score requirements; check websites for other states of interest.

The student will select the most appropriate test(s) (*each 2 hours*) from the following for his/her major area and teaching minor if in a different content field than the major:
