



# Accounting

UW-Superior's major in accounting offers a broad business education that prepares students for careers in accounting and auditing. This comprehensive major requires at least 66 semester credits to complete. No minor is required.

Required courses cover basic and advanced accounting and auditing topics, taxes, accounting for non-profit organizations, fraud examination, and accounting information systems.

In addition, students take courses in computer information systems, economics, finance, business law, business statistics and communication.
