

UW-Superior Interdisciplinary Studies major is entirely available online. With this unique program, you can take those previous credits and through a thoughtful process, plan a degree that will build on both past and new experiences.

Through the Interdisciplinary Studies major, you will work with faculty and your advisor to design a major around three or four areas of study that support your educational and professional goals. Faculty from those areas of study review and approve your major, with final approval awarded by the University Credits Committee.

Program Highlights

- Available entirely through Distance Learning, providing the flexibility of study around your schedule without travel to campus.
- Accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges & Schools.
- A 120 credit degree program which can be completed in one of two forms:
 - 1. A comprehensive major of 54 credits, with general education requirements and elective courses totaling 120 credits.
 - 2. A major of 33 credits in a major with a minor of 21-24 credits in a subject area, general education requirements and elective courses totaling 120 credits. This option meets needs of students who wish to include a minor in their program. You may also combine this option with a second major in a discipline such as Communicating Arts.
- Credit for prior learning may be available through CLEP/DANTES testing or the Documented Portfolio.
- May include past and new learning.
- Note that the Interdisciplinary Studies major is not designed to meet specific professional entry requirements. Be sure to discuss your career goals with your advisor as you consider this major.

Degree Requirements

- 120 or more total undergraduate semester credits (in course numbered 100-499).
- 36 or more undergraduate semester credits in upper-divison courses (courses numbered 300-499).
- A resident grade point average of 2.0 or above for all undergraduate credits.
- 30 or more undergraduate semester credits earned at UW-Superior.
- Last 12 undergraduate semester credits earned at UW-Superior.
- Completion of General Education requirements.
- Completion of all requirements for the Interdisciplinary Studies major.
