

GENERAL EDUCATION ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
for transfer of credits between
The University of Wisconsin-Superior
and the
Gogebic Community College

Effective Date: March 15, 2010

Established Date for Review: January 2014

Introduction and Rationale:

The University of Wisconsin-Superior maintains an educational partnership with Gogebic Community College to provide opportunities for students to transfer coursework between the institutions. This Agreement specifies that the University of Wisconsin-Superior shall consider transfer student holding an Associate of Arts Degree from Gogebic Community College to have satisfied the university-wide general education requirements. The underlying assumption for this Agreement is that the community college courses listed below provide a foundation that prepares students for the degree specific courses required within University degree programs.

Conditions:


Students who have earned an Associate of Arts Degree from Gogebic Community College and who wish to transfer to the University of Wisconsin-Superior will be awarded a minimum of 42 general education credits satisfying Core Requirements, Knowledge Categories, Non-Western and Diversity Requirements required for any of the Bachelor Degrees offered by UW-Superior: Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Fine Arts, Bachelor of Music Education, or Bachelor of Music .

The terms of this agreement apply only for the purposes of satisfying above-mentioned general education requirements at the University of Wisconsin-Superior. Gogebic students seeking admission to specific degree programs offered at UW-Superior must comply with all degree requirements, including any additional general education coursework.


To qualify for a Bachelor Degree, students transferring from Gogebic must also:

- complete a minimum of 48 additional undergraduate credits, of which
 - a minimum of 36 must be in upper-division courses, i.e. course numbered 300-499
 - a minimum of 30 credits must be earned at UW-Superior
 - the last 12 credits must be earned at UW-Superior
- achieve a resident grade point average of 2.0 or above
- complete all programmatic and/or certification requirements for at least one major and one minor or a comprehensive major
- complete general education corequisites in the context of major studies
 - an independent learning experience
 - a capstone senior experience


