

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN PINE TECHNICAL COLLEGE AND THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-SUPERIOR

In order to facilitate the transferability of students who have completed the Accounting Diploma Requirements at Pine Technical College to UW-S, the faculty of the institutions, effective January 1, 2000, agree to allow the transfer of:

- up to 22 semester hours in general education courses
- up to 27 semester hours in the following courses of which no more than 8 will be awarded as business general elective credits

for a total of no more than 49 semester credits, leading to a comprehensive major within the Department of Business and Economics. Credits will be granted only to students who complete a bachelor's degree at UW-Superior in the given major and/or the given cluster.
