TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
between University of Wisconsin—Superior and Wisconsin Technical College System

In order to be admitted to the Teacher Education Program at UW-Superior students will need to show evidence of:

1. Completion of the following General Education Requirements with a minimum grade of C:
 - a. English 101
 - b. English 102
 - c. Comm 110
 - d. HHP 102
 - e. Math 102
2. Completion of TED 200 with a minimum grade of B-
3. Satisfactory scores on the Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST):
 - a. Reading 175
 - b. Writing 174
 - c. Math 173
4. A minimum grade point average of 3.0 on General Education and TED professional coursework (including transfer work accepted as meeting degree requirements)
5. A minimum of 9 resident semester credits at UW-Superior
6. A minimum of 40 semester credits of collegiate level coursework

A minimum of 23 credits is required to complete the Early Childhood Minor for Elementary Education Majors. WTCS transfer students will receive 15.5 credits toward this requirement and will need to complete an additional 7.5 credits, as specified by their UW-Superior academic advisor.

This agreement is effective April 6, 2009 and will apply to students who complete an A.A.S. degree in Early Childhood at an institution of the Wisconsin Technical College System using the approved Wisconsin Technical College Early Childhood Program Curriculum. This agreement may be reviewed at any time at the request of either party; it will be reviewed no later than April 6, 2012.
