1. Trace the history of your interest in this area
Professors, classes, research, interests, etc.
When reporting your undergraduate research, do not be banal!
Name your advisors
2. Prove your capacity to perform
Talk about the difficulty of work and how you handled it
3. What do you want to study/do? This is 80% of your essay.
4. Become a person
Discuss activities, sports or leisure time activities (be brief)
5. Why here? Why do you want to go to this school?
6. End with a statement of vision/mission
Ex: You'll succeed whether you get into this school or not
