**Comment [UO7]:** Each Bullet should start with an action verb. Use Present Tense for anything you are doing currently, Past tense for things that you are not currently doing.  
Hot topics for bullets:  
1) Exper. with special needs & at risk students  
2) Parental Contact  
3) Classroom management  
4) Any extra-curriculars you helped with  
5) Outstanding things you accomplished  
6) Etc.  
Please note this is not primarily a rundown of your job description, show how you stand out!

**Comment [UO8]:** 2 pages is the norm for education resumes due to your number of field placements. If you go to 2+ pages, never have the final page be less than 1/3 to 1/2 used

Please note that every district will be looking for different things: some want 1 page, some will want your entire life story, some will rely more on the application, and some will not care. Due to this you can always call HR and see what they want you to include in your application (i.e. should I include my references or not), do they need anything else specific to their process?

Schools want to see involvement outside of teaching. They want strong role models for not only students, but also for the community at large. It really does improve community relations with the district. Also, Districts want teacher that have outside interests, so that they are less likely to burn out due to stress from only thinking about teaching/work!
