WHO Leadership Superior/Douglas County will annually select approximately 25 participants who want to be involved in improving their community and shaping its future. Participants will be chosen to represent a cross-section of the urban and rural communities of Douglas County in terms of diverse backgrounds and interests.

WHAT Leadership Superior/Douglas County is a program that identifies and cultivates existing and emerging community leaders. This program will help participants broaden their knowledge of the community, develop networks among existing and future leaders, and learn skills needed to participate in meeting the challenges faced by the community.

WHY Participants develop networks with local leaders and community professionals. They have the opportunity to actively participate in the community and develop leadership skills which will be used in many different organizational contexts. Business and organizations that sponsor participants gain employees who have a deeper understanding of challenges faced by the community as well as available opportunities. Participants receive training in topics relevant to local businesses, organizations, and the community. The community gains leaders who have developed a heightened sense of civic concern, responsibility, and involvement.
