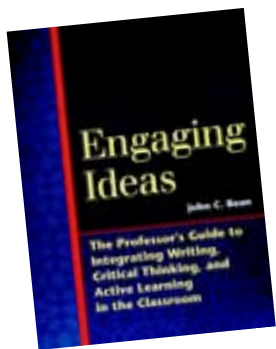
The Fall 2010 CETL book club will meet on the following **Tuesdays**:
