will facilitate the discussion.

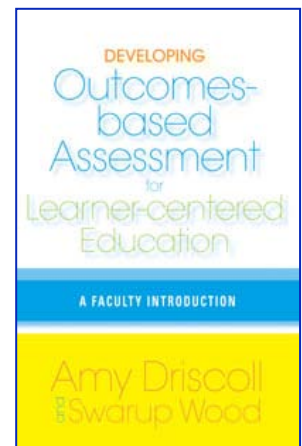
Self-acclaimed novices and skeptics of assessment are particularly welcome.
