Spring 2010 Teaching with Technology Program

This program provides pedagogical and technical support services for the integration of technology into teaching and learning. All Spring 2010 faculty and staff are eligible to apply. Selected instructors will each receive a **\$500 stipend** for their work on ***a project integrating a learning technology into a UW-Superior Spring 2010 course.*** The program supports a limited number of projects per semester. In Fall, the program is generally limited to technology integration projects for First Year Seminars.

How CETL Can Support Your Project

Selected projects will receive a budget of **up to \$100** for technology-related purchases and focused pedagogical and technical support from CETL staff. We can:

- provide **training and support for instructors**
- develop technical instructions and other **training materials for students**
- **demonstrate technologies** for students during your class time or troubleshoot in-class during student work time
- conduct **background research** on best practices for teaching and learning with your selected technology
- **develop examples** of the technology for student use
- serve as **liaison** for Technology Services Department and UW System as needed
- document student experiences with the technology via **video**
- develop online mid-semester and end-of-semester **student surveys** on student experiences in the project, and provide survey results to instructor
- develop **custom technology-based learning materials**

Project Application and Selection Process (Due date: Tuesday, December 22, 2009)

Please submit a proposal of 1 to 2 pages, double-spaced, that includes:

- 1) the course name, course number, and section number
- 2) the technology or type of technology selected (e.g. "WordPress" OR "a blog")
- 3) a description your plan or ideas for integrating the technology into your course
- 4) a statement of how the use of the technology is intended to impact student learning about the course topic
- 5) a description of any prior experience you have in teaching with technologies

Project proposals must also include the signed application form.

Projects will be selected based on technical feasibility, thoroughness of course redesign plans for technology integration, sustainability in future semesters, and anticipated impact on student learning. Proposals will be reviewed by a team designated by CETL.

Project Requirements

- ◆ Projects will integrate one technology or one Learn@UW-Superior tool to enhance student learning that has not previously been used in the course. Projects should involve instructor use and/or student use of the selected technology. Projects should impact in-class and/or out-of-class time appropriately for the technology selected: from a single lesson to the entire semester.
- ◆ Each instructor will be required to administer one mid-semester student survey and one end-of-semester student survey on student technology integration experiences. This will be developed and administered within Learn@UW-Superior by CETL staff.
- ◆ Meetings with CETL staff: Instructors will be expected to meet with Lisa Larson or designated CETL staff at least three times during the semester:
 - Meeting 1 will involve your presentation of your technology integration plans and a discussion of your technology needs and any relevant pedagogical issues prior to course start;
 - Meeting 2, at mid-point in the project, will review technical issues and needs and discuss student experiences based on the mid-semester student survey;
 - Meeting 3 is a final, post-semester meeting to review your integration experiences and best practices recommendations.
 - Additional meetings may be required depending on your project.
- ◆ Each instructor will be asked to submit a written, video, or audio statement about their project by June 1, 2010 for use on CETL's Teaching with Technology Showcase website.

*Please submit your completed 1-2 page proposal and your signed application form by 5p.m. on **Tuesday, December 22, 2009** to Lisa Larson, Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning.
