The Dean of Students Office is taking applications for the scholarships listed below.

Students must write an essay which includes a paragraph for each scholarship they are applying for that explains how they meet the criteria of that specific scholarship. This should be on a separate piece of paper and double spaced.

- Optimist Club Scholarship** - One scholarship worth \$990.00 will be awarded.

To qualify:

- ___ Student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and be a continuing student.
- ___ Student must have been involved in on-campus/off-campus organizations (i.e. athletics, student organization, community service).
- ___ Student must have set a positive example for youth/peers.
- ___ Student must have shown commitment to the service of youth/peers in community activities participated in.
- ___ Student must demonstrate what they have learned through their service to youth/peers.

- Oluf Haugrud Scholarship** – Six to Eight scholarships worth a minimum of \$500.00 will be awarded.

To qualify:

- ___ Student must have proof of academic merit.
- ___ Student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and be a continuing student.
- ___ Student must have participated in significant community service projects.
- ___ Student must have demonstrated outstanding leadership.
- ___ Student must describe what they have learned through their leadership experiences and projects.
- ___ Student must have set a positive example for youth/peers.

- Joe Long Scholarship** - One scholarship worth \$575.00 will be awarded.

To qualify:

- ___ Student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25 and be a continuing student.
- ___ Student must have been a member of a student organization at UW-Superior.
- ___ Student must have demonstrated outstanding leadership.
- ___ Student must describe what they have learned through their leadership experiences and involvement in student organizations.
- ___ Student must show proof of financial need. (US students - a copy of your most recent Financial Aid Award Letter or a copy of the Financial Aid Award Summary from your e-hive account will work.
International Students – Please submit a letter from the International Office.)

- Lloyd Williams Memorial Scholarship** – One scholarship worth \$300.00 will be awarded to a residence hall student.

To qualify:

- ___ Student must be a current residence hall student and a full-time student.
- ___ Student must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and be a continuing student.
- ___ Student must be living in the residence halls for the entire academic year that the scholarship is disbursed.
- ___ Student must describe what activities they have participated in as a member of the residence hall community.
- ___ Student must describe what their educational and career goals are and how this scholarship will help them to achieve these goals.

**RHA and Residence Life staff members are not eligible for this scholarship.

- William & Olga Munnings Scholarship** - One scholarship worth \$350.00 will be awarded to a non-traditional student.

To qualify:

- ___ Student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 and be a continuing student.
- ___ Student must be at least 25 years of age or older and working on their first undergraduate degree.
- ___ Student must have demonstrated dedication to their education and importance of education to them.
- ___ Student must show involvement in Campus Life at UW-Superior and what they have learned from that.
- ___ Student must demonstrate how they have set a positive example for youth/peers.

- Lambda Sigma Lambda/Sigma Sigma Sigma Scholarship** – One scholarship worth \$600.00 will be awarded to one junior who is a female.

To qualify:

- ___ Student must be an undergraduate female student at UW-Superior in junior standing.
 - ___ Student must have a minimum GPA of a 2.5 and be a continuing student.
 - ___ Student must be active in campus life and show commitment to enhancing campus life at UW-Superior.
 - ___ Student must explain what they have learned from being involved in campus life at UW-Superior.
- **Preference is given to applicants who are legacies of Lambda Sigma Lambda/Sigma Sigma Sigma Sororities.
- **The junior who receives the award for the 2011-2012 academic year is eligible for the scholarship her senior year if she fulfills the above requirements.

- Veteran Scholarships:**

Gerald Christensen Scholarship – One scholarship worth \$395.00 will be awarded.

Thomas Jorgenson Scholarship – One scholarship worth \$385.00 will be awarded.

Joseph H. Moline Scholarship – Two scholarships worth \$525.00 will be awarded.

Stone Memorial Scholarship – One scholarship worth \$400.00 will be awarded.

VFW Scholarship – One scholarship worth \$710.00 will be awarded.

To qualify:

- ___ Student must be a veteran or a son/daughter or
 - **a grandson/granddaughter of a veteran (VFW Scholarship only).
- ___ Student must demonstrate their dedication to their education and its importance to them.
- ___ Student must show their involvement in their community or campus life at UW-Superior.
- ___ Student must explain their connection to military service and what it has meant to you.
- ___ Student must provide verification of their service or their parents/grandparents service in the military.

Carl & Helen Kunz Scholarship – One scholarship worth \$650.00 will be awarded.

To qualify:

___ Student must be a junior level student

___ Student must plan to carry out research or a project during their senior year that applies directly to the field of reminiscence and life review within their major area of study.

The following criteria apply:

1. The research or project is a formal part of the student's major area of study that requires research or a project that will be carried out during the student's senior year.
2. The proposed research or project reflects a clear understanding of the field of reminiscence and life review.
3. The research or project will further the knowledge of how reminiscence and life review is related to the student's field of study.
4. There is reasonable evidence that the research or project will be able to be carried out successfully during the student's senior year.
5. The student commits to preparing a final report and related poster session that would be appropriate for publication in the news letter of the International Institute for Reminiscence and Life Review and/or as a poster session at their biennial conference (this does not mean that publication or presentation is required).

Answer the 4 questions below on a separate piece of paper and attach it to this form, ALSO type them in Microsoft Word and submit them in an email to dseguin@uwsuper.edu .

1. What is the title of your research or project?

3. How will this research or project further the field of reminiscence and life review within your field of study?
