Alumni Scholarship Program Criteria

INCOMING FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP

- A. High School students must rank in the top 25 percent of their graduating class.
- B. Students must enroll as a full-time undergraduate student (i.e. 12 or more credits per semester). The recipient may not be a relative of anyone involved in the selection process.
- C. Students must be offered admission to UW-Superior prior to receiving the scholarship award.
- D. The recipient may major in any field of study.
- E. Scholarship recipient may not receive more than \$1,500 in other scholarship awards in the same academic year.
- F. Criteria for evaluation will be ranked in the following order:
 - 1. Rigor of course and activity load
 - 2. Grade point average or class rank
 - 3. Expression and creativity of thought in answers to essay questions
 - 4. Participation in co-curricular activities
 - 5. Letter of support from a counselor, teacher or advisor
- G. Scholarship awards will be presented in the spring.
- H. Scholarship recipient will receive a \$1,000 award (\$500 each semester).
- I. Recipient will be selected by the UW-Superior Admissions Department.
- J. Applications must be received by the Admissions Office no later than **March 31**.
