QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a UWS student with a 2.0 GPA or higher
 - Preference will be given to work study

 - Must demonstrate customer service skills
 - Preference given to students who have previous work experience in a food service industry position and or hold a current Food Safe Sanitation Certificate.
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RESPONSIBILITIES

- Schedule all Concessions Attendants for athletic contests, special events, and other requests during the academic year
 - Training, evaluating, and rewarding employees
 - Ordering, purchasing, and picking up orders related to Concessions
 - Managing the concession inventory
 - Maintenance, ordering and repair of concession equipment
 - Interacting with University and community groups
 - Managing any problems that arise in the concession stand
 - Attending weekly meetings to discuss operations and other matters
 - Writing, reviewing, and revising policies and procedures
 - Maintaining a clean concession stand that is up to code with the local and state department of health and safety
 - All other duties as assigned by Supervisor
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TIME COMMITMENT & TRAINING

 - Work and training occurs during the academic year, will include evenings and weekends
