- 4.1 Remove the grade of WF (withdraw failing). Due the changes in the Withdraw policy, students will now be required to drop/withdraw within a defined time period. If students fail to drop/withdraw by the 60% deadline and a petition for a late drop/withdraw is denied, students will be graded accordingly. No longer will the Registrar’s Office inquire with each faculty member of each student who totally withdraws after the deadline to see if the student should be assigned a W or WF grade.
