Ahlgren Journalism Scholarship _____

For junior or senior students who have participated in radio, television or journalism activities. The students may or may not be majoring in one of the mass communication-journalism disciplines.

Alpha Psi Omega Scholarship _____

For a sophomore, junior or senior of good academic achievement, financial need and proficiency in drama and another speech area.

Dorothy McKay Anderson Scholarship _____

For students in fine arts (art, music, communication) or English, preferably a graduate of a Superior or Duluth high school.

Pacey Beers Scholarship _____

For students at least in their junior year, but no further advanced academically than the first semester of their senior year, and have completed at least two years of enrollment at UW-Superior. Students must have a theatre and/or music major, have a minimum overall cumulative GPA of 2.5, and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 in their theatre or music major. The candidates shall have participated actively in any phase of the public performance activities of the theatre or music programs at UW-Superior.

Walter C. Bridges Scholarship _____

For students in journalism and communications who show academic merit and financial need.

Ted Garver Scholarship _____

For a student working five hours or more per week with KUWS with a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Graham Sisters Scholarship _____

For Communicating Arts majors who are Distance Learning students.

Katz Family Scholarship _____

For an upper-division status student of academic excellence and majoring in communication.

Dr. O. Gayle Manion Scholarship _____

Full-time junior or senior students admitted to the department of Communicating Arts.

Ben L. Munson Memorial Scholarship _____

For students pursuing a broadcasting career.

Kathryn Ohman Scholarship _____

For outstanding students in drama.

Ivy Rose Weaver Scholarship _____

For a sophomore or junior student majoring in theatre with a GPA of 3.0 or greater. A senior level student who is completing their degree in a fifth year may be considered eligible for the award. First preference will be given to students in scenic design/technical direction. Second preference will be given to students in lighting and sound design. Third preference will be given to students in costuming. The recipient must maintain their work in University Theatre and their GPA to receive the award for spring semester. The scholarship may be repeated.
