REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION TO UPPER DIVISION (300/400-LEVEL SBE COURSES)

Students majoring in the SBE must be admitted to the school prior to enrolling in 300/400-level courses with the exception of 300/400 level economics courses. Students enrolling in 300/400 level economics courses only need to satisfy Econ 250 and Econ 251 prerequisite requirement.

Admission Requirements:

1. 2.3 overall cumulative GPA required (including transfer courses).
2. Complete the following SBE core courses with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 and with no grade lower than C- :
¹ACCT 200, ¹201 ²ECON 250, ²251 and ¹BUS 270.
3. Complete **WRIT 102**, **209 COMM 110**; **MATH 151** or **240**.
4. Complete all University StudyCourses.
5. Students may not enroll on a Pass-Fail basis in any of the courses listed in 2 & 3.
6. Complete the SBE graduation plan, have it signed by your advisor and turn it in along with this application.

Conditional approval may be granted if:

1. All core requirements are satisfied the semester of admission.
2. All but 12 credits of the University Studies requirements are satisfied the semester of admission, or
3. By SBE Appeals Petition.

Students with majors offered by the SCHOOL OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS may not enroll in any of the courses listed in 2 or 3 on a Pass/Fail basis. The University Studies Mathematics requirement is satisfied by MATH 151 or 240.

All of the requirements stated above also apply to transfer students.

Global Awareness (6 credits)

Two courses (6 credits) of one foreign language **or**

Two courses (6 credits) 300 level or higher from the Global Studies Minor

Students can complete either a Bachelor of Arts (BA) or a Bachelor of Science (BS) degree with an International Business concentration. Students who choose to complete the International Business concentration Bachelor of Arts degree must fulfill all requirements of that degree including the foreign language requirement as outlined in University catalog.

Notes:

- BUS 370, BUS 380 and FIN 320 cannot be taken at the same time as BUS 495.
- 120 total credits and 36 credits numbered 300 or higher are required for graduation.
- Students with more than one major in SBE must have a minimum 5-course difference between majors. The five or more courses that differ between majors must be a combination of required major/concentration courses and elective courses.
