Academic Advisement (Old Main 134, x8515) provides resources for advisors and advisees as well as assistance with advisement concerns and questions.

Academic Service Learning (Swenson 2047, x8518) is credit bearing, educational experience in which students participate in an organized service activity to gain further understanding of course content and an enhanced sense of civic responsibility.

Athletics (Marcovich Wellness Center, 715-395-4693) provides a variety of opportunities for men and women to participate in intercollegiate athletics at the NCAA Division III level. The purpose of the athletic program is to enrich the student's collegiate experience.

Career Services (Swenson 1061, x8024) Provides students and alumni with opportunities and resources to identify career goals and develop life-long career management skills. Career Services also hosts the job site Jacket Jobs, which hosts on and off-campus jobs, internships and volunteer opportunities.

Campus Recreation (Marcovich Wellness Center Info Desk, 715-395-4610) Campus Recreation provide an array of recreation and wellness opportunities, including intramural sports, fitness, outdoor recreation, an indoor climbing wall, aquatics, sports clubs, and an on-campus challenge ropes course.

Campus Safety (Corner of Belknap and Catlin, x8114) provides safety services to the campus and local community. Registers bikes on campus.

Dean of Students Office (Yellowjacket Union desk, x8244) provides assistance with issues that affect academic performance or personal well-being, help to report grievances, and assist with an extended leave of absence from campus.

Dining (A'viands) (Yellowjacket Union, x8102) Dining Services, provided by A'viands, is your on-campus dining provider, with service at the Union Café, Brick Oven Grill and Jacket Java. Dining Services also provides free nutrition counseling.

Disability Support Services (Swenson 1024, x8188) assists student with registered disabilities with accommodations for classes and around campus.

Gender Equity Resource Center (Swenson 1031, x8091) works to create a safe environment within the campus community and assist individuals of all genders and sexualities to work, socialize and live together.

Financial Aid (Old Main 110, x8200) oversees disbursement of financial aid packages, assists with questions and concerns regarding financial aid, FAFSA, and scholarships. Processes payment for student employment.

First Year Experience (Yellowjacket Union 230, x8024) supports new students with their transition into the UW-Superior community.

Jacket Book and Supply (Yellowjacket Union, x8278) course books, supplies and UW-S gear are available here.

International Programs (Old Main 337, x8138) provides services and programs for international students, and domestic students wishing to participate in study abroad or National Student Exchange.

Multi-Cultural Affairs (Old Main 230, x8084) is dedicated to the academic and social success of African American, American Indian, Asian American and Hispanic/Latino students while fostering a climate of respect for all people and cultures.

Parking Services (Corner of Belknap and Catlin, x8177) enforces parking policies, and is responsible for the sale of parking permits.

Registrar's Office (Old Main 139, x8228) the keeper of the students' educational records and transcripts.

Residence Life (Yellowjacket Union desk, x8438) provides housing options for students.

Student Involvement (Yellowjacket Union desk, x8244) provides a wide array of opportunities in partnership with the larger University community and intentionally engages students in practical learning experiences. By getting involved you can meet new people, try new things, build your resume, enhance leadership skills, and make a difference.

Student Government Association (Yellowjacket Union 156, x8432) is the voice of the students and puts those voices into action.

Student Health & Counseling Services (Marcovich Wellness Center 1729 x8236) provides mental health counseling, outreach programming, food shelf, and a partnership with local medical facility for students.

Student Support Services (Swenson 1024, x8185) is a content area tutoring lab that offers one-on-one tutoring, small group tutoring, navigating campus computer software, computer use and a quiet study area.

Study Abroad (Old Main 337, x8138) assist students with researching and arranging study abroad opportunities.

Technology Services (Swenson 2090, x8300) provide technology services that are accessible, reliable, convenient and secure for the purpose of empowering the UW-Superior community to use technology in teaching, learning, research, creative activity and service.

Union Desk (Yellowjacket Union desk, x8244) is your one stop shop for campus information, ID cards, fax services, dining services, specialty copies, building lost and found, YU room

reservations, and student organization mailboxes. It is also the access point for Residence Life, the Dean of Students Office, and Student Involvement.
