- Small Sealed Lead Acid (SSLA/Pb)
- All models of cell phones and their batteries up to 11 pounds each

Batteries **NOT** Accepted:

- Alkaline, Lithium and other Non-Rechargeable batteries
- Button batteries
- Wet cell Ni-Cd (nickel-cadmium)
- Wet cell lead acid vehicle batteries

Its as Easy as 1 .. 2 .. 3!

Step 1 – Bag It



Insert one battery or cell phone in the bags provided. If no bag is available, cover the terminals with tape.

Step 2 – Seal It



Remove the plastic strip from the top of the bag and seal.

Step 3 – Drop It



Deposit sealed bag into the box.
