- First Nations Studies: FNS has recently had to curtail its offerings to reflect lower levels of staffing. On March 3, after approving these expedient changes as a temporary measure, UAAC approved a resolution to “recommend to administration that it establish as a high priority the restoration of the FNS program to its previous level of staffing.”
