'Jacket Cash

All UW-Superior students have the option of purchasing Jacket Cash from the Yellowjacket Union Information Desk, 715-394-8244. Jacket Cash is used instead of U.S. money to purchase food, beverages, and meals in the Yellowjacket Union at discounted prices. A declining balance electronic account that uses the Student ID card for access is created for each customer.
