



Educational Administration

UW-Superior's Educational Leadership Department offers graduate and postgraduate academic programs leading to a Master of Science in Education (MSE) degree and a Specialist in Education (Ed.S.) degree. The educational Administration program has been preparing leaders in education since 1950.

Program Options

The Master of Science in Education program is designed for educators with limited or no administrative experience who are seeking their initial professional preparation and certification for school leadership positions. It includes a yearlong practicum in each student's area of specialization.

The Specialist in Education program is a planned professional program for educational administrators who wish to increase their competencies or satisfy certification requirements for their current position or positions with increased responsibilities. It includes a yearlong internship and a thesis.

Convenience

Both Educational Administration programs are designed to fit into the schedules of working professionals. The MSE degree can be completed in as little as two semesters and two summers. Courses are offered at UW-Superior and at outreach sites at UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point. Classes are offered Saturdays and evenings, and some classes are available online. UW-Superior has transfer agreements with UW-Eau Claire, UW-Stevens Point, and UW-Madison.

Faculty

Students receive a first-rate education taught by faculty with real world experience in the field. Students in the Educational Administration graduate programs enjoy face-to-face, personalized advisement with professors who know them by name.

Facilities

The Educational Administration program is housed in Swenson Hall. Students enjoy access to state-of-the-art classrooms with modern technology and inviting work and common areas that enhance the overall learning experience.
