

## STUDENT PERMITS

There are two types of Student Parking Permits that are valid in most UW-Superior Parking lots.

- COMMUTER
- RESIDENT HALL

There are two ways to get your parking permit.

1. *By stopping by in person with your completed form to the Public Safety Building (Parking Services Office).*
2. *You may also mail-In your completed Student Parking Permit Application Form using the address on the form.*

It is the responsibility of the motor vehicle operator to be aware of UW-Superior parking regulations, and to find a legal parking space.

**Public Safety offers** vehicle  
unlocks and jump starts with a  
\$20.00 service charge...if they  
are successful.

**All UW-Superior parking  
permits (except motorcycle and  
special single use paper  
permits) are of the transferable  
hanging type.**

If the owner of the permit has more  
than one vehicle, the  
permit may be used in  
whichever vehicle is currently  
being parked in a campus  
parking area. Permits must be  
hung, clearly visible, from the  
inside rearview mirror to be valid.

**SPECIAL NOTE: Ownership  
of permits is not transferable.**

Never purchase or take a permit  
from another person as that  
permit may have been reported as  
lost or stolen. This would make  
you subject to violation of parking  
regulation **Fraudulent or Illegal  
Permit**, with a current fine amount  
of **\$60.00** and/or of state statute  
**UWS Chapter 18.08(8)(a, b, or c)  
Misuse of Parking Services**, with  
a current possible fine amount of  
**\$295.00**.

**UW-Superior Parking Permits  
are not valid on City streets.**

## **SPECIAL ATTENTION**

**City Streets:** *A City of  
Superior residential permit is  
required to park on city  
streets surrounding the  
campus with the exception of  
Mortorelli Drive. UW-Superior  
parking permits are not valid  
on city streets. Parking on the  
streets is enforced by the  
Superior Police Department.*

**Reserved Parking:** *Student  
parking is prohibited in the  
upper part of Lot 12.  
(Reserved purple permit)  
Also in the signed area in lot 7  
and lot 11 in spaces  
designated by a yellow or blue  
reserved permit sign.*

***The lack of a legal  
convenient space is not  
considered a valid  
excuse for parking  
illegally.***
