QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a UWS student in good academic standing
- Previous indoor or outdoor climbing experience is helpful
- Dependable and Trustworthy
- Excellent people skills
- Ability to work with all ages
- Ability to work autonomously and in teams
- First Aid/CPR/AED required during term of employment. We will provide certification classes. You must achieve certifications within the first 3 weeks of employment

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Insure all paperwork and liability waivers are signed and collected for each participant
- Maintain check in and check out of students, staff and faculty
- Enforce all rules, policies and procedures
- Monitor check out and return of climbing wall equipment including harnesses, ATCs, carabiners, etc.
- Monitor the physical and emotional safety of all participants
- Maintenance of all climbing gear
- Create, set, and maintain new routes
- Facilitate participants and groups on safe climbing and belaying techniques
- Work on kids programming and teaching participants in climbing, knots and belaying
- Other duties as assigned

TIME COMMITMENT

- Belay certification classes, refreshers and training
- CPR/AED/First Aid certification class
- Scheduled in-services and meetings
- Annual Rock On! climbing competition including pre and post preparation and clean-up
- Winterfest
- Scheduled classes and events on the wall during non-climbing wall hours
