QUALIFICATIONS

- Previous indoor and/or outdoor rock climbing experience
- Ability to work with all ages of all populations in a variety of group sizes
- Excellent people, communication, and organization skills
- Must be a UWS student in good academic standing

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Provide instruction to participants in climbing skills
2. Monitor check out and return of climbing wall equipment including harnesses, belay devices, carabiners, helmets, etc.
3. Assist with maintenance and inventory of gear and equipment
4. Log gear use and assist with evaluating for replacement
5. Ensure all liability waivers and health history forms are properly signed and collected for each participant
6. Ensure students, staff, faculty, and community members sign in and sign out
7. Enforce and communicate climbing wall policies and procedures
8. Create, set, and maintain new routes
9. Facilitate participants and groups on safe climbing and belaying techniques
10. Other duties as assigned

TIME COMMITMENT & TRAINING

- Must be willing to work Weekends, Nights, & Events as necessary
- 5-10 a week during Academic year
- Preference will be given to those who are willing and able to commit to work a Full Academic Year
