- Ability to work with all ages of all populations in a variety of group sizes
- Excellent people, communication, and organization skills
- Must be a UWS student in good academic standing

- Advanced training in wilderness medicine (WFR, WFA, etc.)
- Climbing Wall Certification (PCIA, AMGA, CWA)

### RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Supervise climbing wall attendants
2. Assist with recruiting, hiring, training, and evaluating employees
3. Coordinate scheduling of climbing wall attendants
4. Oversee and manage equipment inventory and equipment maintenance
5. Coordinate and manage route setting and related training(s)
6. Develop and implement programs for students, faculty and staff, and community members
7. Train Climbing Wall Staff in climbing wall policies and procedures
8. Enforce and communicate policies and procedures to staff and participants
9. Ensure all paperwork and liability waivers are signed and collected for each participant
10. Log gear and equipment use and coordinate retirement of equipment with Outdoor Recreation Specialist
11. Other duties as assigned
