QUALIFICATIONS

- Excellent people and communication skills
 - Ability to work with all ages of all populations
 - Ability to work with large groups
 - CPR/AED/First Aid certification (or willing to obtain)
 - Belay certification prior to training. This can be attained at the MWC indoor climbing wall
 - Previous climbing or ropes course experience is desired
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RESPONSIBILITIES

- Facilitate groups on ropes course according to the reserved and scheduled time
 - Responsible for mitigating inherent risks using current ACCT industry standards
 - Adhere to “challenge by choice” philosophy
 - Guide, direct, and motivate participants in a safe setting
 - Set up and take down activities on the ropes course
 - Facilitate events specific to the goals of the group
 - Ensure proper safety measures are taken during course events
 - Debriefing the experience in a manner relevant to the group and their goals
 - Be familiar with all course policies and procedures including emergency and weather protocols
 - Perform regular inspections on the ropes course and equipment
 - Inventory ropes course equipment
