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RESPONSIBILITIES

- Facilitate groups on ropes course according to the reserved time
 - Set up and take down activities on the ropes course
 - Facilitate events to the goals of the group
 - Ensure proper safety measures are taken during course events
 - Debriefing the experience in a manner relevant to the group and their goals
 - Be familiar with all course policies and procedures including emergency protocols
 - Perform regular inspections and maintenance on the ropes course and equipment
 - Inventory ropes course equipment
 - Responsible for mitigating inherent risks of ropes course operations using current industry standards
 - Guide, direct, and motivate participants in a safe setting
