RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Supervise Lifeguards and aquatics inventory
2. Assist with recruiting, hiring, training, and evaluating employees
3. Coordinate scheduling of Lifeguards
4. Oversee inventory and maintenance of equipment
5. Design, implement and facilitate aquatic programs to increase pool attendance
6. Train Lifeguards in policies and procedures
7. Responsible for mitigating inherent risks
8. Implement Risk Management practices specific to the UW-Superior pool
9. Enforce all rules, regulation, policies and procedures
10. Perform regular water and facility inspections and report it to professional and facility staff
11. Other duties as assigned

- Office hours 5-10 a week during Academic year
- Preference will be given to those who are willing and able to commit to work a Full Academic Year
