

PETITION TO THE CREDITS COMMITTEE INDIVIDUALLY DESIGNED (Non-Comprehensive) MAJOR

REQUIREMENTS: A maximum of three faculty need to be involved in the development and approval of the IDM plan if there are more than one discipline areas featured in the IDM plan.

1. Minimum of 33 total major credits
2. Student must take IDS 301 Individually Designed Major Planning course. This is an online, pass/fail, one credit course available to all students.
3. Student must declare a minor or second major in a different subject area. The same courses cannot be used to meet the Individually Designed (non-comprehensive) major requirements as well as minor or second major requirements.
4. A minimum of 18 credits must be in courses numbered 300 or higher
5. Plan of courses included on the IDM petition form must include a Capstone course
6. Student must have earned at least 43 credits prior to submitting the IDM petition form.
7. Must submit (and have approved by the Credits and Student Reinstatement Committee) an Individually Designed major (non-comprehensive) petition form.
8. The petition form must be developed in consultation with the student's advisor and at least one faculty member representing disciplines other than that of the advisor.
9. A GPA of 2.00 is required in major where at least one course must be a resident credit course.
