CRIME REPORTS

April 1 - 30, 2011

- Apr 3rd: Two female students were both cited for Underage Drinking – Second Offense within one year, and are both subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50.
- Apr 4th: A male student was cited for Possession of Marijuana and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50.
- Apr 5th: A student reported the theft of some cash from unattended purse in the Music Student Lounge room in the Holden Fine Arts Building.
- Apr 9th: A Crownhart Hall RA reported that a resident had apparently stolen some “Study Bucks” from the lobby area. This matter is being handled from within.
- Apr 12th: A student sent in a report to us via our on-line reporting system that her bicycle had apparently been stolen from the bike rack outside the Yellowjacket Union at some time between 7:00pm and 10:30pm on 04/12/2011.
- Apr 13th: A student reported that her vehicle was parked in lot #7 on 04/07/2011 between 5:00pm and 8:00pm and was apparently the victim of minor damage hit & run to a parked car. There was no note left on her vehicle as is required by state law.
- Apr 14th: A student reported that another resident of McNeill Hall had been harassing her verbally and with remarks left on her Facebook account. This matter is being handled within by the Residence Life Office Staff and the Dean of Students Office Staff.
- Apr 15th: A female student was cited for Underage Drinking – First offense, and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
- Apr 16th: A female student was cited for Underage Drinking – Second offense within one year, and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50.
- Apr 23rd: Three female and one male students were all cited for Underage Drinking – First offense, and are all subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
- Apr 26th: A Staff Member reported that someone(s) had apparently vandalized the 4th floor men’s restroom and in a portion of the hallway with what appeared to be soap, or shampoo, and shaving cream.
