A Campus Safety Officer found a window pane broken on the entry door to the Old Main Building by the Registrar's Office. It did not appear that entry was made to the building.

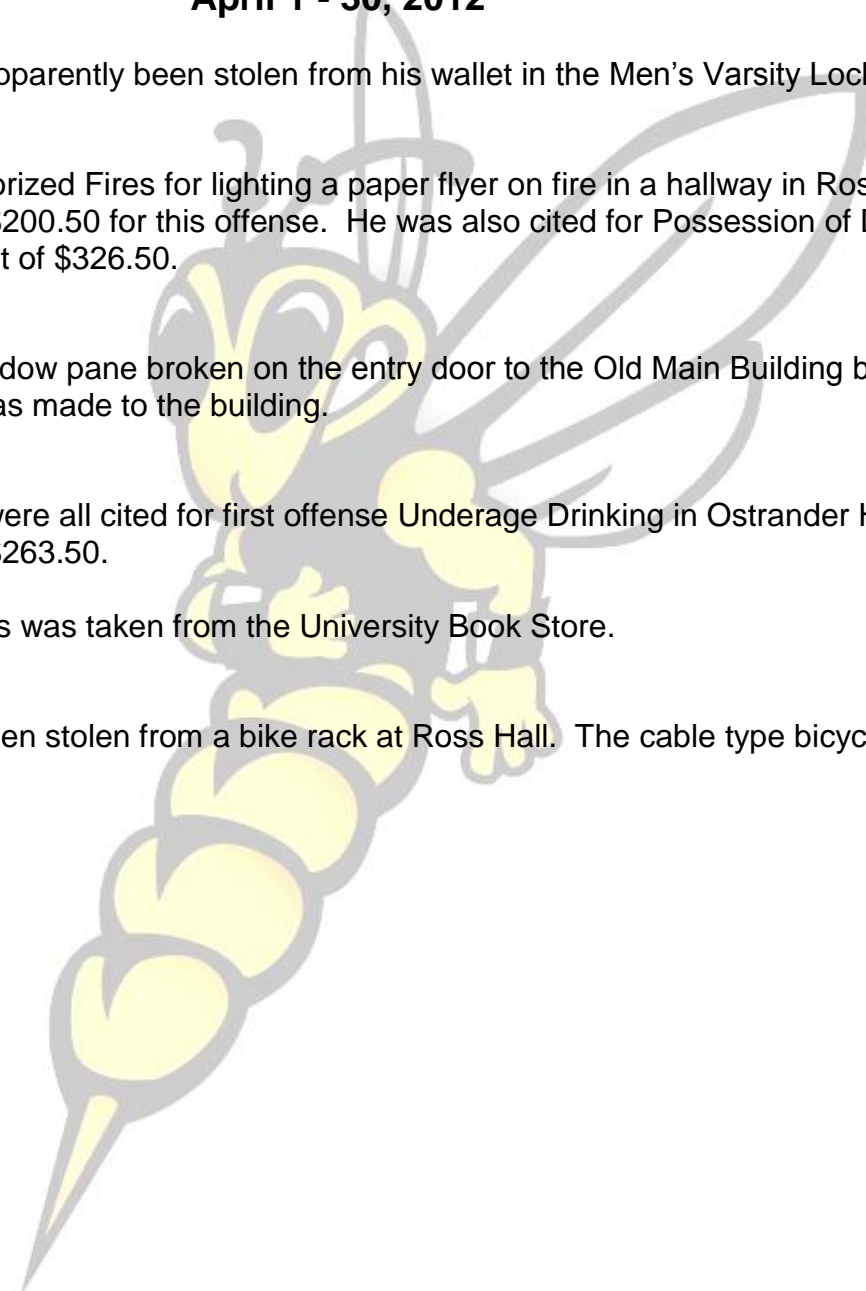
### **April 28<sup>th</sup>:**
