## INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT

### December 1 - 31, 2017

<b>Dec 1<sup>st</sup></b>	After responding to a noise complaint in Curran/McNeill Halls, three males were cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
<b>Dec 2<sup>nd</sup></b>	After responding to a possible Underage Drinking call in Curran/McNeill Halls, two males were cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
<b>Dec 3<sup>rd</sup></b>	After responding to a report of a strong odor of marijuana in Curran/McNeill Halls, one male was cited for Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Tampering with Fire Equipment. He is subject to fine amounts of \$389.50, \$326.50, and \$326.50.
<b>Dec 4<sup>th</sup></b>	A report was received that a sexual assault had occurred on 12/02/2017 in Ross Hall. The victim declined to press criminal charges for now but the incident is under investigation by the Title IX Office.
<b>Dec 13<sup>th</sup></b>	After responding to a noise and possible underage drinking call in Curran/McNeill Halls, six females were cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
