INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT February 1 - 28, 2018

Feb 5th	A report was received of a vehicle driving recklessly in the Ross Hall parking lot. The vehicle was located and the driver warned about his driving. While speaking to the driver the officer observed potential contraband and requested assistance from the Superior Police Dept. The male driver was subsequently cited for Possession of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia which carry possible fine amounts of \$381.50 and \$326.50 respectively.
Feb 8th	A student reported he lost his wallet at the Marcovich Wellness Center and later learned it had been found. Upon receiving it back he discovered money was missing. The investigation determined the money had been removed by a student employee. The money was reimbursed, the victim declined to press charges and the matter was handled internally.
Feb 9th	A report was received from a Campus Security Authority (CSA) relating to a sexual assault which had occurred in November of 2015 in a residence hall room. The victim did not report it to the CSA until 02/08/2018. The victim declined to press charges and the incident is under investigation by the Title IX/Dean of Students Offices.
Feb 10th	After responding to a call of a possible underage drinking situation on the 3 rd floor of Curran/McNeill Halls, three males were cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, and are all subject to possible fine amounts of \$263.50.
Feb 13th	After responding to a report of the odor of marijuana coming from a room on the first floor of Curran/McNeill Halls, a male resident surrendered suspected marijuana and some drug paraphernalia. The male resident was cited for Possession of Marijuana with a possible fine amount of \$389.50 and for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia with a possible fine amount of \$326.50.
Feb 18th	After responding to a report of possible odor of marijuana on the second floor of Curran/McNeill Halls, a male resident was cited for Possession of Marijuana with a possible fine amount of \$389.50 and for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia with a possible fine amount of \$326.50.
Feb 23rd	<p>A report of possible threats was received from a faculty member. The matter was followed up on by Public Safety and the Dean of Students Office.</p> <p>A report was received of a suspicious male inside Curran/McNeill Halls. The male was located outside the building and was identified as a non-student. He related he was trying to locate someone he had met at an off-campus event. He received a verbal warning and later received a letter from Residence Life banning him from all residence halls.</p>
