INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT January 1 - 31, 2013

Jan 1st: Outside of Old Main someone(s) had used spray paint to mark several areas with graffiti.

In Ostrander Hall, a male student was cited for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$326.50. He was also cited for Possession of Marijuana and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50.

Jan 3rd: Outside of Holden Fine Arts Building someone(s) had used spray paint to mark several areas with graffiti.

Jan 7th: In Curran-McNeill Halls, two male students were both cited for Possession of Marijuana and are subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50 each. They were also both cited for Smoking in Building and are subject to a possible fine amount of \$200.50 each. One was also cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
