**INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT  
January 1 - 31, 2015**

<b>Jan 9<sup>th</sup></b>	A Campus Safety Officer received a call from a concerned person about a vehicle driving around in lot #3 erratically. Upon responding and locating the vehicle, an under aged adult male was found to be sitting in the driver's seat. When asked to exit the vehicle a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage was detected and a bottle of vodka was found in the back seat area. The male was cited for Underage Drinking-second offense within one year, and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50.
	A report of possible Vandalism to several locks in the Jim Dan Hill Library and Old Main was received. Upon investigation it was determined that 9 locks in the Library and 7 locks in Old main had been glued at between sometime in the afternoon of 01/07 and the morning of 01/09/2015. All of the locks were repaired within the next few days by the Campus Locksmith.
<b>Jan 23<sup>rd</sup></b>	A report of Vandalism to a parked vehicle in Lot #5 was received.
	A report of the possible theft of a cell phone from a person's purse in the Health and Wellness Center was received.
<b>Jan 26<sup>th</sup></b>	While patrolling in Lot #3, a Campus Safety Officer observed two individuals sitting in a parked vehicle at about 2:19am. The parties were checked on and it was determined that they had been smoking Marijuana in the vehicle. One party in the vehicle had a small amount of a green leafy substance consistent with marijuana and drug paraphernalia which were confiscated. The adult male was cited for Possession of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia and is subject to possible fine amounts of \$389.50 and \$326.50
