## INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT

### January 1 - 31, 2018

<b>Jan 3rd</b>	The university's plumber reported smoke coming out of a fan outlet in Holden Fine Arts room# 1223. Public Safety and the fire department responded. He was able to determine the cause to be an electrical wire smoldering due to an overheated oil reservoir and he was able to disconnect it. No serious damage was noted and repairs were made.
<b>Jan 4<sup>th</sup></b>	Public Safety responded to a report of a male and female engaging in sexual activity in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> floor lounge in Crownhart Hall. The couple were found to be non-residents who had been visiting a student. No charges were filed and both were escorted out of the building.
<b>Jan 11th</b>	Public Safety responded to a fire alarm at Ostrander Hall which was determined to have been caused by food overcooking in the basement kitchen. The Superior Fire Department set up fans to clear the smoke and students were allowed to re-enter once the alarm system could be reset.
<b>Jan 22nd</b>	A female student reported that her vehicle had been struck by a pick-up truck in lot #12 as she was pulling out of her parking spot. The driver of the pick-up truck did not stop. She was able to obtain a license plate number and the matter is followed up on by Public Safety. Her vehicle received very minor damage.
<b>Jan 24<sup>th</sup></b>	Public Safety responded to a report of a marijuana odor in the hallway of the 3 <sup>rd</sup> floor in Ostrander Hall. The officer made contact with a student in the room the odor was believed to be coming from but she denied any involvement. Nothing was noted in the room to substantiate charges.
<b>Jan 25th</b>	Superior Police Officers were escorted to a room in Crownhart Hall for the service of a search warrant. The resident was cooperative and was not arrested.
<b>Jan 27<sup>th</sup></b>	Public Safety responded to Crownhart Hall on a report of a marijuana odor on the second floor. A possible source room was identified and the door was knocked on and answered. There was no detectable odor of marijuana at the time and nothing was found in the room. The residents were cooperative.
<b>Jan 28<sup>th</sup></b>	Public Safety and the Superior Police Dept. responded to Crownhart Hall for a loud verbal disturbance between a male and a female. The female was a student resident and the male was her boyfriend. The two parties and witnesses were talked to but no basis for criminal charges was found.
