## INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT March 1 - 31, 2012

### **March 6<sup>th</sup>:**

A call was received that a flyer taped to a door to the second floor northwest stairwell of Ross Hall had been intentionally set on fire. Damage to the door is estimated to be about \$100.00. This case is under investigation.

### **March 10<sup>th</sup>:**

Two males were cited for Prohibited Use or Possession of Alcohol while attending a function in the Yellowjacket Union. Both are subject to a possible fine amount of \$200.50.

### **March 16<sup>th</sup>:**

A student reported she believed her vehicle had been struck while it was parked in Lot #3B between 03/14 and 03/16 when she noticed the damage to the rear passenger side. A review of surveillance video for that time period failed to confirm the damage had occurred at that location.

A student reported that her vehicle was apparently struck by another vehicle in Lot #3B on 02/29/12 during a snow storm. Surveillance video was reviewed and officers were able to identify the vehicle responsible for the damage. The driver of the other vehicle has been identified and interviewed. Charges are pending.

Received notification from the Superior Police Department that they were investigating a report of an alleged Sexual Assault of a child which had occurred in Hawkes Hall on either 2/14/12 or 2/15/12. The incident did not involve anyone connected with the university. Public Safety provided assistance with crime scene identification and photography.

A MWC staff member reported finding several exercise bands which had been intentionally cut in the Dance Studio.

### **March 19<sup>th</sup>:**

A male student was cited for first offense Underage Drinking in parking lot #6 (Hawkes Hall) and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.

A male student was cited for first offense Underage Drinking outside of CMO and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.

### **March 25<sup>th</sup>:**

A male student was cited for first offense Underage Drinking in Ross Hall and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50. A female student was also cited during the same incident for No Smoking-Residence Hall and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$200.50.

**March 28<sup>th</sup>:**

The Yellowjacket Union Book Store reported at least four worthless checks were passed by the same individual on 03/19/12 and 03/20/12. This incident is under investigation.

**March 31<sup>st</sup>:**

Two male and one female students were all cited for first offense Underage Drinking in Ostrander Hall and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
