**INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT
March 1 - 31, 2015**

Mar 8th	Campus Safety responded to a report of possible Underage Drinking occurring in Ostrander Hall. Two male residents were subsequently cited for 1 st offense Underage Drinking and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50. A third male resident was cited for 2 nd offense Underage drinking and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50.
	A short time later Campus Safety received a report of a possible marijuana odor coming from a room on another floor in Ostrander Hall. The officer made contact with the room occupants. A male visitor admitted to possessing a small amount of marijuana and was cited for Possession. He is subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50.
Mar 10th	A staff member reported the theft of a small amount of cash from a desk drawer in the Jim Dan Hill Library.
Mar 21st	Campus Safety responded to a report of a physical assault that had just taken place in Hawkes Hall. Officers from the Superior Police Dept. also responded. Following their investigation a male resident was arrested by SPD and lodged in jail on charges of domestic abuse assault.
Mar 24th	A student reported her car had been broken into behind the Pilgrim Lutheran Church while she was in class. The only thing taken was an eReader that had been left out in the open. A campus-wide reminder was sent out via the Staff and Student Digests to not leave items of value in plain view in vehicles.
Mar 28th	Campus Safety received a report that a vehicle had just struck the fence adjacent to the soccer practice field. The caller also provided the vehicle description. As the officer arrived in the area he observed a vehicle matching the description travel south on Mortorelli Drive. The vehicle was stopped and assistance was requested from the Superior Police Dept. A male UWS student in the vehicle admitted to being the driver when the fence was struck and he was subsequently arrested by SPD for Operating a Motor Vehicle while Intoxicated. The damaged fence has been repaired and restitution is being sought.
