INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT March 1 - 31, 2018

Mar 9th	SSC reported a soap dispenser was vandalized in a Crownhart Hall 3 rd floor restroom.
	IT reported a student had not returned a borrowed computer and was not responding to messages left for her. An officer made personal contact with the student who promised to return it right away. IT confirmed it was returned and no criminal charges were issued.
Mar 16th	SSC reported graffiti was found in a Crownhart Hall 1 st floor restroom.
	Public Safety responded to an RA report of a possible marijuana odor on the 2 nd floor of McNeill Hall. The officer identified the room the odor was coming from and requested assistance from the Superior Police Dept. Suspected marijuana and drug paraphernalia were located and two male residents were arrested on these charges by SPD. One of the males was also cited for Tampering with Fire Safety Equipment as he had disabled the smoke detector in the room. This offense carries a possible fine amount of \$326.50.
Mar 18th	A student reported she had been physically assaulted by another UWS student while they were in Duluth. The incident is under investigation by the Dean of Students office and the Duluth Police Dept.
Mar 28th	A student reported that someone had entered his vehicle parked in lot #5 and stole \$10.00 in cash and a gold colored chain. He thought the vehicle had been locked but no signs of forced entry were found.
	A student reported that someone had entered her vehicle parked in lot #3A and stole a Holiday Gas Gift card. She believed the car had been locked but no signs of forced entry were found.
