CRIME REPORTS

May 1 - 31, 2011

May 4th: An anonymous report of a sexual assault was filed with the Superior Police Department and forwarded to our agency. The incident is alleged to have occurred in the basement of Ostrander Hall on or about 04/20/2011.

May 8th: A student reported the theft of his laptop computer from the 3rd floor lounge of Crownhart Hall.

May 11th: Six male and one female students were all cited for Underage Drinking – first offense within one year, and are all subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.

May 11th: A male student was cited for Disorderly Conduct, lodged at the Douglas County Jail, and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$295.00.

May 12th: A staff member reported that there had been damage done to two parking signs in lot #12 in an apparent attempt to possibly steal them.

May 14th: A male student was cited for Underage Drinking – first offense within one year and Deposit of Human Waste and is subject to possible fine amounts of \$263.50 for each offense.

May 15th: A student reported the theft of his laptop computer from his room in Ostrander Hall.

May 20th: A staff member reported that a student had apparently been using another student's ID card to make nine (9) transactions at the Yellowjacket Union cafe from 05/12/11 through 05/17/11. The student making the fraudulent purchases was contacted and has made full restitution. The victims have declined to pursue criminal charges.
