INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT May 1 - 31, 2012

May 1st:

A student reported he believed someone had punctured a tire on his vehicle while it was parked in the Ross Hall parking lot. A review of the video surveillance of the area where his vehicle was parked did not show anyone puncturing his tire during the timeframe he had given to the officer. Case closed as unfounded.

A student reported that his personal entertainment device had apparently been stolen from the Ross Hall basement computer lab.

May 5th:

A male student was cited for Underage Drinking, second offense within one year, and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50. A female student was also cited, for first offense Underage Drinking, and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50. This incident occurred near the Ole Haugrud Field.

May 10th:

A former male student was cited for first offense Underage Drinking after being found sleeping in the 4th floor lounge of Ross hall. He is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.

May 15th:

Two male students were cited for first offense Underage Drinking in Ross Hall and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.

In an unrelated incident, a female student was cited for Underage Drinking, second offense within one year, in Ross Hall following the investigation of a verbal argument. She is subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50.

May 17th:

A staff member reported Vandalism/Damage to Property in the 4th floor hallway of Ostrander Hall. Several items were broken including a light fixture cover, a mirror and the glass on a fire extinguisher cabinet.

May 18th:

A student reported that his food storage cabinet in the 2nd floor kitchen area of Ross Hall had apparently been broken into and a chef knife was missing from it.

May 21st:

A student reported that her food storage cabinet in the 2nd floor kitchen area of Ross Hall had apparently been broken into and several food items and spices were taken.
