INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT

May 1 - 31, 2014

May 5th	A student reported that the seat had been stolen off of her bicycle while it was locked in the Hawkes Hall bike rack.
May 10th	Two students were cited for underage drinking in Curran/McNeill Halls. One female student's second offense charge carries a potential forfeiture of \$389.50 while the male students' first offense is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50. Sometime overnight someone wrote various things in chalk on the west outside wall of Ross Hall. The matter was referred to Facilities Management for clean-up.
May 16th	A student reported his cellular phone was stolen from the common area on the 2 nd floor of Hawkes Hall. He later advised it had not been stolen, only misplaced. This case status was changed to unfounded. A student reported that while he was in the process of moving out of Ostrander Hall, someone entered his unlocked room and stole a leather shoulder bag.
May 20th	Miron Construction reported that a red Honda ATV was stolen overnight from their work site by the Heating Plant. This theft is being investigated in conjunction with the Superior Police Dept.
May 30th	While staff members were cleaning out a room in Curran/McNeill Halls they discovered a small bag of suspected marijuana which was turned over to Campus Safety for further investigation.
