**INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT  
May 1 - 31, 2017**

<b>May 5<sup>th</sup></b>	Public Safety responded to a report of possible underage drinking occurring in Curran-McNeill hall. Two female residents were subsequently cited for Underage Drinking (first offense) and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
<b>May 8<sup>th</sup></b>	Public Safety responded to a report of an intoxicated male causing a disturbance in Ross Hall. The male resident was cited for Underage Drinking (first offense) and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
<b>May 12<sup>th</sup></b>	A female student reported damage to her vehicle that had occurred overnight while her car was parked in lot #3A. The driver's side rear view mirror had been knocked loose from its mounting.
<b>May 18<sup>th</sup></b>	A female staff member reported the theft of a television set from a room in Old Main sometime after 5:00pm on 05/17.
<b>May 20<sup>th</sup></b>	A SSC Custodian reported that three metal plates underneath the sinks in the 3 <sup>rd</sup> floor men's restroom in Curran-McNeill hall had been damaged.
<b>May 21<sup>st</sup></b>	A female student reported she had been sexually assaulted on several occasions during the semester by a male student acquaintance. The victim declined to press charges at this time but the matter is under investigation by the Title IX Coordinator's office.
<b>May 23<sup>rd</sup></b>	A female student reported her bicycle had been stolen from the bike rack in front of Curran-McNeill Halls. The case was later unfounded after the student advised it hadn't been stolen but had been brought to the Ross/Hawkes Hall complex for safekeeping by a friend of hers.
