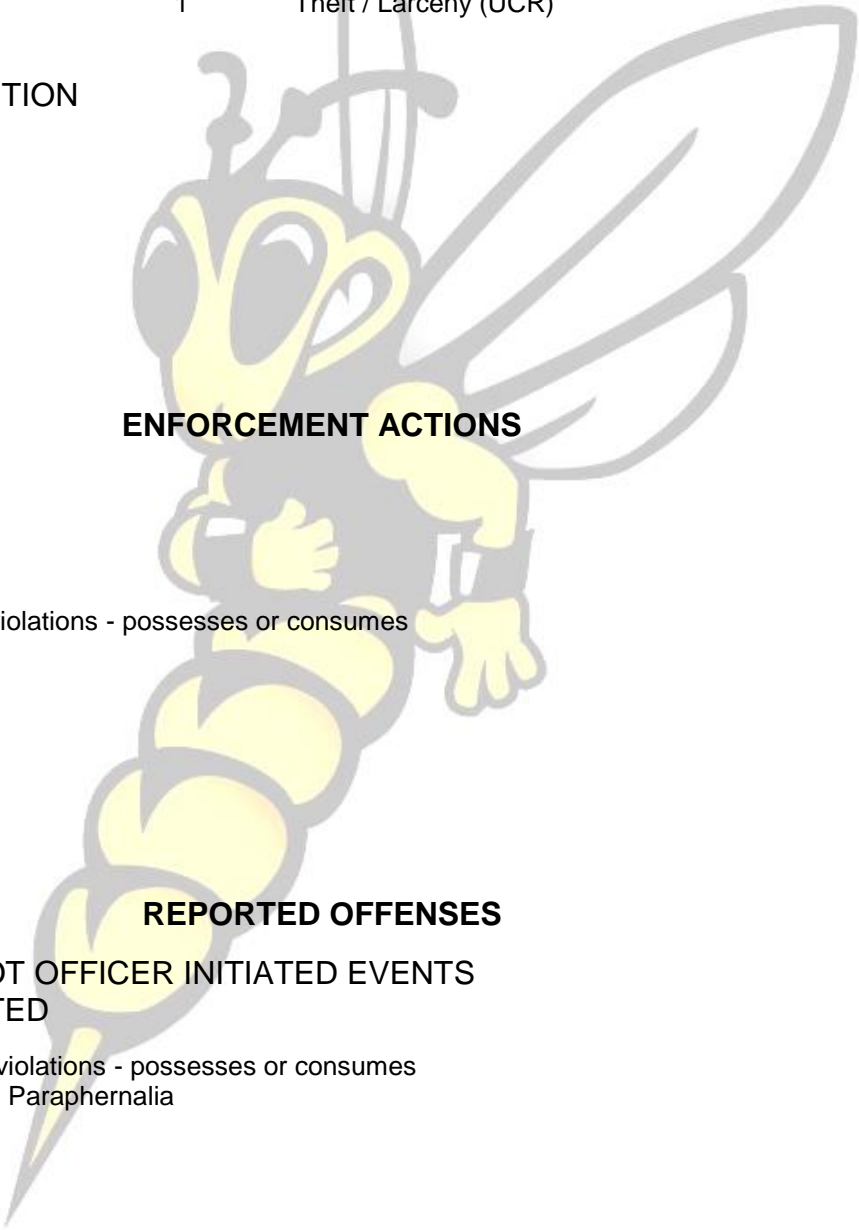

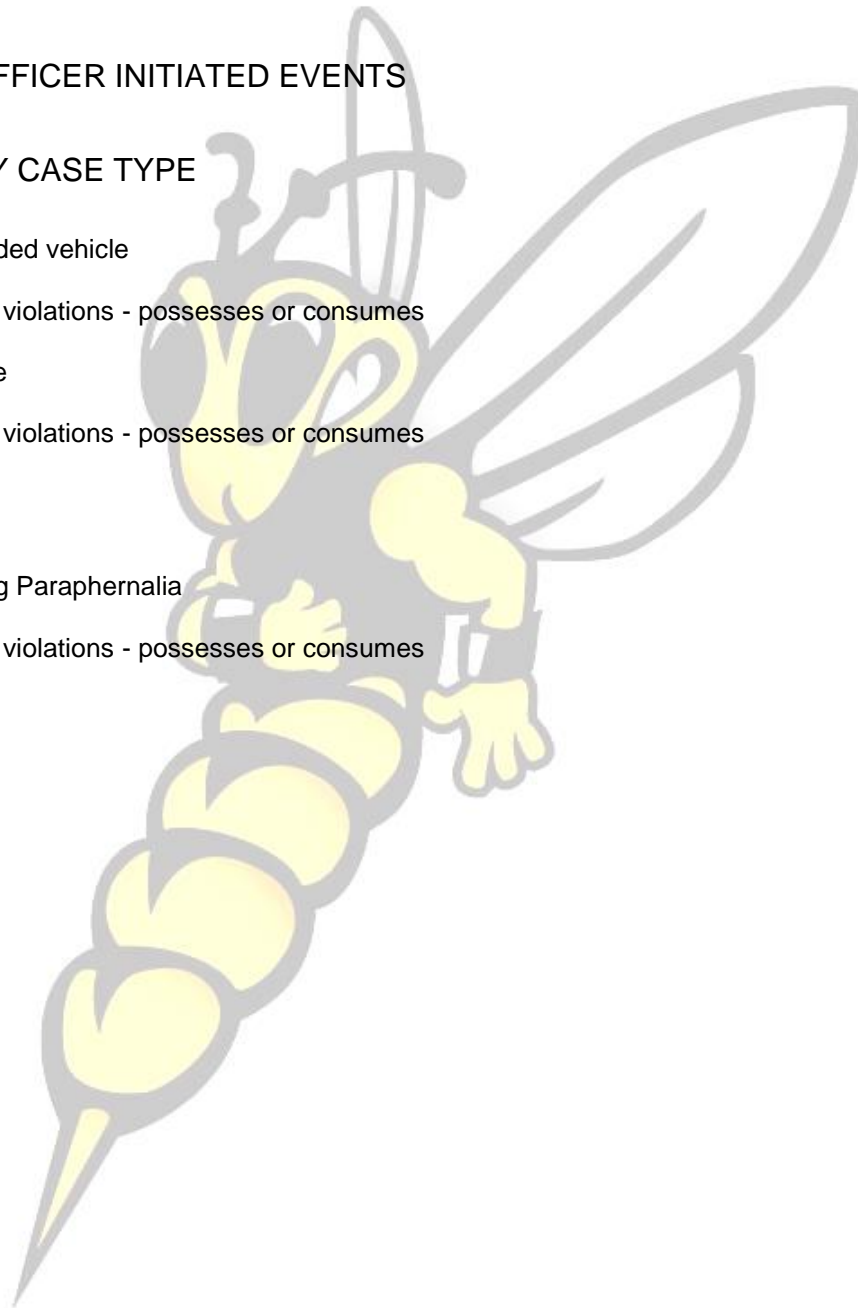

## INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT November 1 - 30, 2012

**Nov 2<sup>nd</sup>:** A student reported that her vehicle that was parked in Lot #3A was hit by another vehicle that was parked next to it at some time between 12:00am and 12:49pm. This incident is under investigation.

**Nov 3<sup>rd</sup>:** In Ostrander Hall, one male and one female student were both cited for Underage Drinking- first offense, and are both subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.

**Nov 4<sup>th</sup>:** In Crownhart Hall, a male student was cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50. David A. Mejia and Thomas P. Tourinho were both cited for Underage Drinking – second offense within one year, and are subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50.

A male student was cited for Fire Safety-Failure to Evacuate and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$200.50.

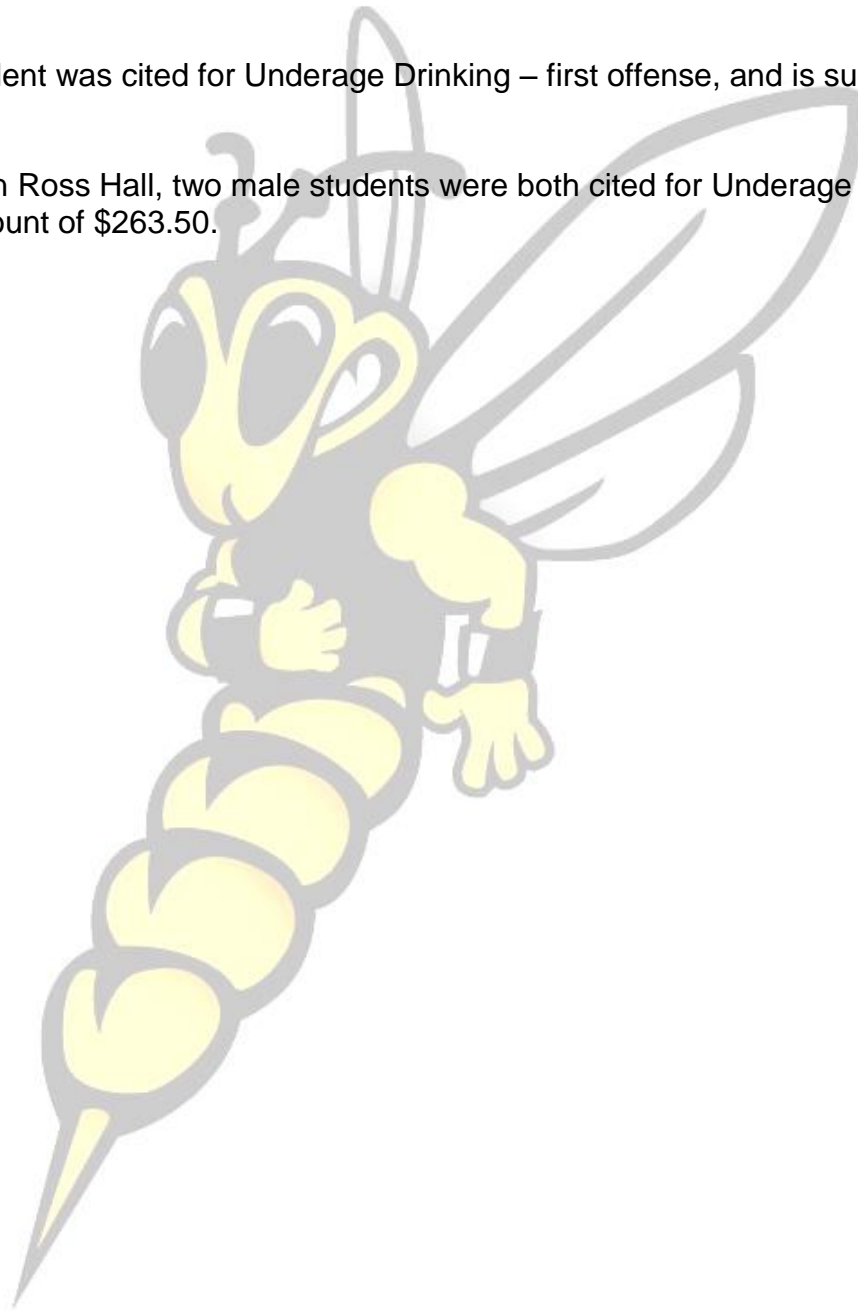
