## INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT November 1 - 30, 2014

<b>Nov 1<sup>st</sup></b>	Campus Safety received a report of possible underage drinking occurring in Ostrander Hall. As a result, one male student was cited for Underage Drinking/Possession – first offense (subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50).
<b>Nov 5<sup>th</sup></b>	Campus Safety officers responded to a report of a loud room and possible underage drinking occurring in Ostrander Hall. One individual fled from officers at the scene but was located three hours later. He was cited for Resisting/Obstructing Police Officer, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Underage Drinking/Possession – second offense (subject to possible fine amounts of \$452.50, \$326.50, and \$389.50 respectively). Two other males also were cited; one for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (subject to a possible fine amount of \$326.50), and one for Underage Drinking/Possession-first offense (subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50).
<b>Nov 9<sup>th</sup></b>	An Ostrander Hall resident reported that a guitar and a game console had been stolen from his unlocked room while he was gone.
<b>Nov 10<sup>th</sup></b>	Campus Safety received a report of a possible marijuana odor in Curran-McNeill Hall. The officer's investigation resulted in a male student being cited for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (subject to a possible fine amount of \$326.50).
<b>Nov 13<sup>th</sup></b>	A student reported that the catalytic converter had been cut off and removed from his vehicle while it was parked in Lot #5 between 11:15 pm on 11/11/2014 and 12:17 on 11/12/2014.
<b>Nov 15<sup>th</sup></b>	An officer located a vehicle in Lot# 5 that had been vandalized. From all appearances some or all of the damage may have occurred somewhere else. The vehicle owner later reported the vehicle's battery had apparently been stolen also. This matter remains under investigation.
<b>Nov 16<sup>th</sup></b>	An officer patrolling near Ole Haugrud Stadium shortly after 2:00a.m. stopped to check on a male standing by a vehicle. The subject was subsequently cited for Underage Drinking-second offense (subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50).
<b>Nov 17<sup>th</sup></b>	A Campus Security Authority (CSA) reported to Campus Safety that two female students confided they had been sexually assaulted by the same male the week before. Both incidents were alleged to have occurred in Crownhart Hall on different days. Both victims wanted to remain anonymous and do not want a criminal investigation conducted. These incidents are being investigated by the University's Student Conduct Officer and temporary sanctions have been issued against the alleged offender.
<b>Nov 19<sup>th</sup></b>	Officers responded to Ostrander Hall on a report of an individual having trouble breathing, possibly due to drug use/abuse. The male student was transported to the hospital by ambulance. Following an investigation, another student who was present was cited for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (subject to a possible fine amount of \$326.50).

	An hour later officers were called to check on a possible marijuana odor in Curran-McNeill Hall. Officers were able to identify the room the odor was emanating from and made contact with the male occupant who was subsequently cited for Possession of Marijuana (subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50).
<b>Nov 21<sup>st</sup></b>	<p>A student reported that the catalytic converter had been cut off and removed from his vehicle while it was parked in Lot #3. He reported the theft had occurred sometime between 8:15 pm on 11/20/2014 and 2:55 pm on 11/20/2014.</p> <p>A female staff member reported that the catalytic converter had been cut off and removed from her vehicle parked in Lot #2 sometime between 10:15 am and 4:00 pm on 11/21/2014.</p>
<b>Nov 24<sup>th</sup></b>	Campus Safety received a report from an individual who said his cell phone and a small amount of cash had apparently been stolen from a locker he had used in the MWC men's locker room while he was there refereeing a game over the weekend.
