**INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT
November 1 - 30, 2015**

Nov 2nd	While responding to a call of criminal damage to a vehicle a Campus Safety Officer and a Superior Police Officer determined that an adult male resident of Hawkes Hall had damaged the side of a vehicle with a piece of plastic and that resident was arrested and lodged by the responding Superior Police Officer for criminal damage to property and resisting arrest. Internal actions have been taken by the Student Conduct Council in this matter.
Nov 7th	While responding to a possible Underage Drinking call in Ostrander Hall it was determined that three adult females (two residents) had been drinking and were each cited for Underage Drinking-first offense and are all subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
Nov 14th	While responding to a loud party call in Curran/McNeill Halls it was determined that an adult female resident had been drinking an alcoholic beverage and was cited for Underage Drinking-first offense and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
